Information for Authors

Submission of a manuscript implies that the work described has not been published before, that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that it will not be publish elsewhere unless it has been rejected by the editors of *Annales Mathematicae Silesianae*.

Manuscript should be written in English and sent in duplicate to the Editorial Office: Instytut Matematyki, Uniwersytet Śląski, Bankowa 14, 40-007 Katowice, Poland.

An abstract of not more than 15 lines should describe the main results of the paper. Included into the footnotes of the first page should be the Mathematics Subject Classification (2000). Key words and phrases may follow. It is necessary to indicate an abbreviated title which will be used as a running head (up to 60 characters including spaces). Figures should be prepared in a form suitable for direct reproduction. Sending PS, EPS, PCX files will be most helpful.

References should be numbered and arranged in alphabetical order, or in the case of the same author, chronologically. The style and abbreviations should follow the Mathematical Reviews.

Authors affiliations, including complete postal address and e-mail address, should be given at the end of the manuscript.

The Editorial Office encourages submission of articles written in Te_X, *AMS-TeX* or La_Te_X. On acceptance of the paper authors will be asked to send the final hard copy and the file on a diskette or by electronic mail to: annales@ux1.math.us.edu.pl.

Recommended font size of manuscripts is 11pt, line length 126mm, page height 192mm. The authors are kindly asked to match their typographical style to that used in the last issue of our journal.

Copies of all manuscripts should be retained by the authors. In case of several coauthors indicate one author as the corresponding author. The author will obtain one set of proofs for corrections after acceptance of the manuscript. 25 reprints of a published paper will be sent to the author at no charge.
